studied organ and sacred music in Hanover under Prof. Ulrich Bremsteller. In 1990 he assumed the post of organist and choir director at the Principal Church of St. Nicholas in Flensburg. In 1993 he was appointed professor at the Felix Mendelssohn Bartholdy Academy of Music and Theatre and university organist in Leipzig. He has been professor of artistic organ performance and director of the sacred music department at the Lübeck Academy of Music since 2004. In January 2005 he was named titular organist at the Church of St. James in Lübeck, since 2009, he has the same position at the Concert Hall in Magdeburg.



He won several international organ competitions while still a student. He has concertized in Germany and abroad, and gives masterclasses. Numerous productions and CD recordings convey a vivid impression of the breadth and diversity of his repertoire, with its center occupied by the works of Johann Sebastian Bach, Max Reger, and the German romanticism.
